Kicks off Saturday October 14 2017.**

Philadelphia, PA (October 2017)- On Saturday October 14, 2017, the team that produces one of the city's largest outdoor festivals ([2nd Street Festival](#)), kicks off [Second Street Sessions](#), a series of "open door" performances in and around the businesses of Northern Liberties.

The theme for Session #1 is "you do you" and the bars, restaurants galleries, and other shops along N 2nd Street will host their favorite musicians and other performers from **5pm to 10pm**. All activities are free and open to the public (some venues are 21+). The diverse musical offerings will span acoustic, jazz, and big brass – whatever is true to the character of that venue.

Look out for the stilt walker! Numerous outdoor performers give this event a real "New Orleans Frenchman Street" feel including magician [Joshua Mesado](#). Horn players The [West Philadelphia Orchestra](#) will march their unique blend of madness and music all up and down the street. Featured indoor entertainers are Erica Corbo and Soul Samurai at Heritage, [Slo & Shakey](#) (Shakey Lyman & Slo Johnson) and John Markov & Willie Mitchell at El Camino, and The Muller Band at Wahlburgers. Additionally, some of 2nd Street Festival's favorite craft vendors will also be setting up shop in or around participating venues.

Retail shops and cafes are staying open late too! This includes Art Star, Poke Bowl, Madison K Live Life Fun, Soy Café and more! The event spans six blocks of 2nd Street between Germantown and Green streets in Northern Liberties.
